COVID Information

This week the government of Alberta announced that public health measures will be phased out in 3 steps. On Thursday, February 10, Canadian Rockies Public School shared a <u>letter</u> that outlines our updated protocols. For further details, please see the <u>CRPS reentry plan</u>.

On Monday February 14, 2022 all mandatory masking requirements will be removed in schools. While mask mandates have been removed, students may elect to continue wearing masks at their own discretion.

Staff in the school will continue to wear masks unless they are socially distanced and cohorted with their classrooms. Here is how the new regulations will impact Canmore Collegiate High School on Monday

- Sports will resume with team travel
- Spectators may resume with limited seating at school events. All guests must wear masks.
- We will continue to limit movement in the building by
 - 8:10 8:30 in the morning
 - 1:40 2:00 at the end of lunch
 - Students still eat in their block 3 class
 - Students may leave school for lunch but will only be allowed back in the building at 1:40 pm
 - No volunteers/guest speakers in the school. Only essential service providers
 - Closed Campus continues: School doors will remain locked throughout the school day.
 - Visitors will enter school by appointment only. All visitors will require masks
 - Wolverine Den/Cafeteria remains closed.
 - No gym use at lunch.
- We will continue to promote physical distancing where possible



Canmore Collegiate High School fees are now available on PowerSchool Parent Portal. Debit or credit card payments can be made online through your Parent Portal


