WINTER GEAR LIST for Snowshoeing

Please bring all of the following items for each day of the program. It is important for the comfort, safety, and enjoyment of the entire group that all participants are outfitted appropriately.

Clothing:

-Gloves or mitts

-Toque (warm hat)

-Pants:

~Base layer: long underwear bottom

~Insulating layer: fleece or polyester (not cotton)

~**MANDATORY: Waterproof outer layer: snow/ski waterproof pants**

-Tops:

- ~Base layer: long underwear top (not cotton)
- ~Insulating layer: fleece or polyester (no cotton or jeans please)
- ~Waterproof outer layer: snow/ski waterproof jacket

Outdoor Gear:

- Day pack (30 L)
- 1 Litre full Water bottle or more (must be 1 L)
- MANDATORY: winter boots or insulated hiking boots**
- hearty lunch and snacks-optional: trekking poles

Personal Items:

- Personal Medications
- Lip Balm
- Sunscreen

Home Work Support Room

We have now restarted our Homework Support Room for our Grade 9 and 10 students. As it has been a while since we have had this opportunity for students, please read the rationale for this program below.

Completion of classroom assigned work is crucial to a student's academic success. A zero given on an assignment because work is not completed is not a true assessment of student learning. To ensure true assessment of student learning, we believe it is important for students to complete classroom assigned work. To assist students in establishing successful study practices and understand the importance to their learning in completing assigned work, we will work with our Grade 9 & 10 students to help them complete missing assignments. Grade 9 & 10 students who are not completing assigned work will be asked by their teacher to attend a homework support room during lunch time to do any missing work. During this time, students will be given help in study skills and in completing the missed learning tasks. A failure to attend these study sessions will result in administrative contact with parents to pursue options to help the student successfully complete their work.

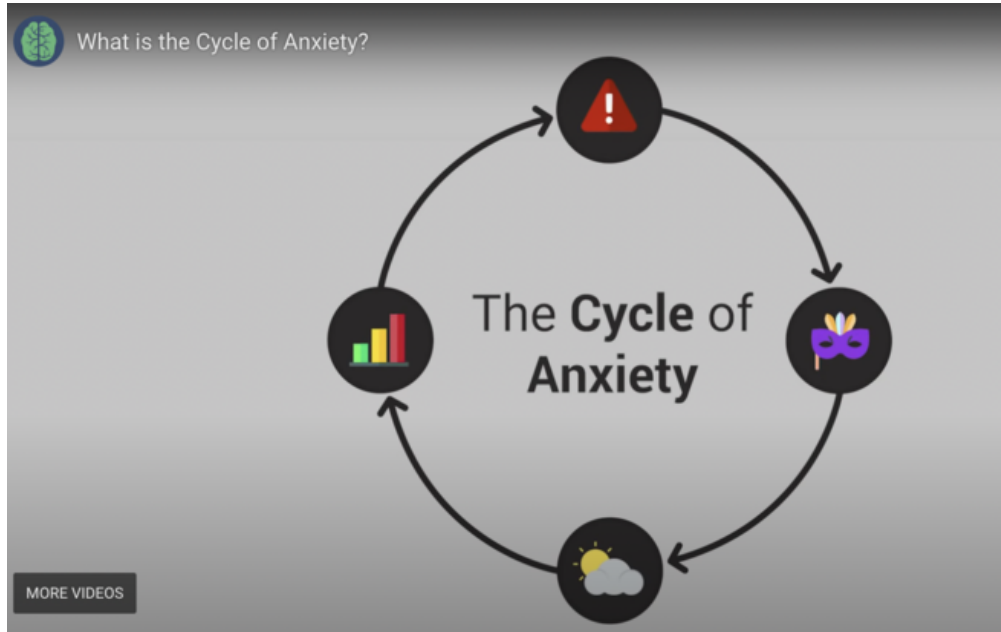

COVID Protocols Update - AHS Step 2

On March 1, 2022 the Alberta Government moved to “Step 2,” of the easing of our public health measures. Our school district sent out a letter earlier this week outlining how step 2 has adjusted out protocols for safety. For further information on these adjustments, please see the attached divisional [re entry plan](#). At our school these changes impact us in the following ways:

- Students are no longer required to cohort - as a result, social areas like our Wolverine Den have been reopened
- Students are permitted to leave and reenter the building during lunch hour
- Staff and students are no longer required to wear masks in the building
- Students using public transportation for Alignment classes at CCHS are required to wear masks
- Students are still required to isolate and follow the daily [AHS checklists](#) when they have COVID symptoms
- The school will no longer be reporting to families individual COVID cases
- Extracurriculars and sports may continue

Please note that throughout the school day, our doors will remain locked and we ask visitor to make appointments when entering the building. Visitors are asked to ring the new doorbell at the Purkis Hall doors.

Leaving class early:

If your student must leave school early for the day or for part of the day, for an appointment, please notify the school. Students must sign in and out of the office if they are leaving school or returning after an appointment (note this in not required during lunch hour).
