### **Out of Province Post Secondary Fair**

All Grade 11 and 12s should attend this post secondary planning not-to-be-missed opportunity on Friday October 21st from 9am-11am at CCHS. ### **Grade 12 Diploma Exams and Grade 9 Provincial Assessment Tests**

Alberta Education announced last week that diploma exams for Grade 12 courses will be weighted at 20% during 2022-2023 only. The exam schedule is now on our website. All Grade 9 students will also complete Provincial Assessment Tests in May and June 2023 in English Language Arts, Social Studies, Math and Science.

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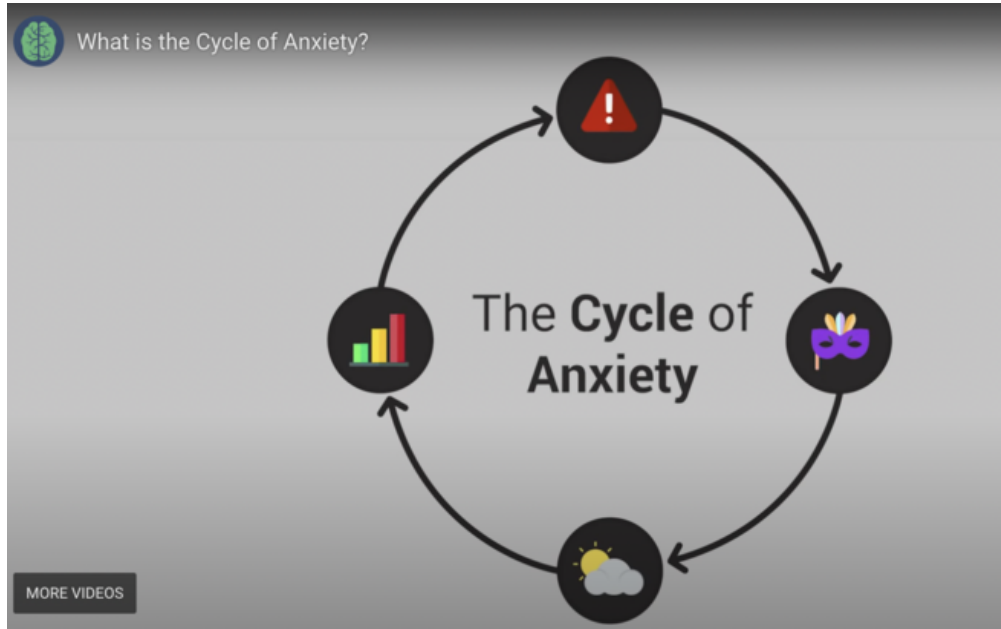
