Parenting Anxious or Worried Youth (for parents and caregivers with children/youth ages 7-18)

As a part of our practical parenting series, this workshop is for parents or caregivers of children/youth who experience anxiety or worry. This program aims to increase parent's capacity to use positive parenting strategies that can help children overcome their anxiety.

Girls Connect (for youth ages 10-13)

This program is designed for self-identifying girls ages 10-13. Being a tween can be stressful and this program focuses on fostering a welcoming and safe environment to discuss, explore and ask questions on important topics. Individuals are encouraged to get involved in facilitated discussions and fun activities where there are opportunities to practice the skills needed to succeed in school, relationships, and into teenage life.

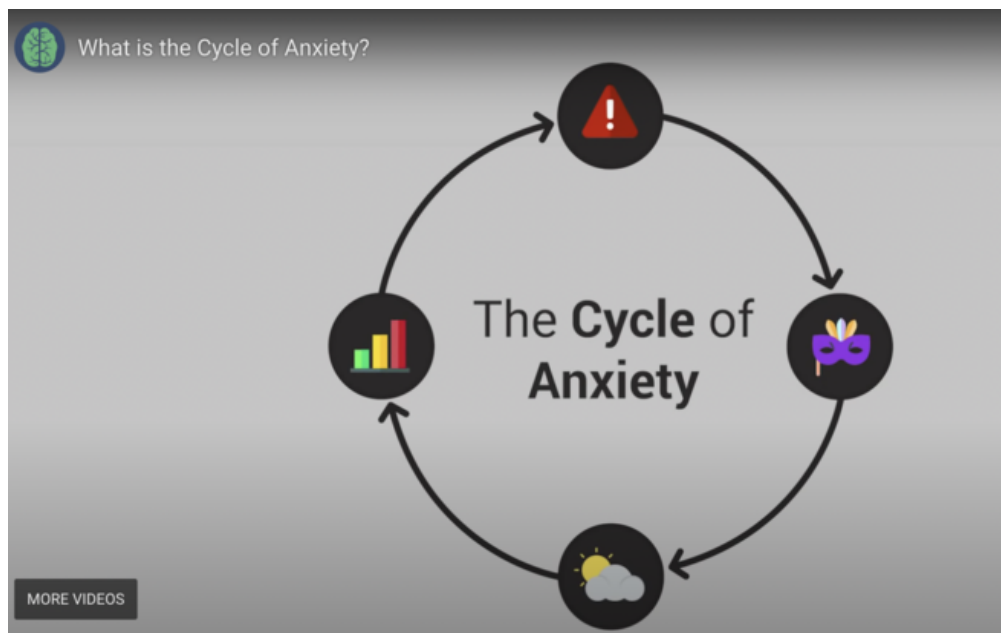
