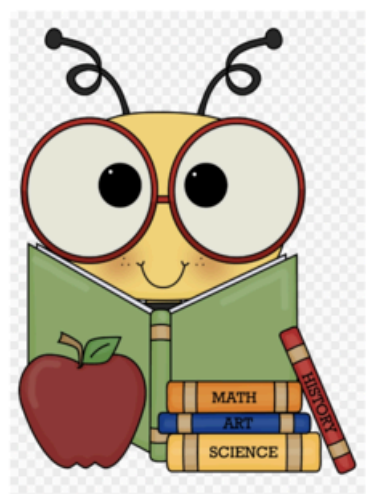

Student Timetables 2024-2025

A reminder that students now have a paper copy of their timetable for 2024-2025. Please go through this with your student and make an appointment at the main office if there are any requested changes. Please note that **June 14, 2024** is the last day to make changes. Other than Grade 12s - changes will not be made in the fall.

What to expect on exam days!

1. Enjoy grab and go **breakfast** in the cafeteria each exam day
2. Leave **phones / backpacks / smart watches** locked in your LOCKER (or at home)
3. **Return your textbook** to the library the morning of your exam (unless your teacher provides another option)
4. Be at your exam location at 8:45am
5. **After your last exam**, hand in your **combination lock** at the main office.



Academic Notes

Diploma exams this week are English Language Arts Part A on Tuesday and Social Studies Part A on Wednesday. Grade 9 have their next **Provincial Assessment Tests (PAT)** in FLA 9 Pt. B on Tuesday, English Language Arts PT B on Wednesday and Math Part A on Thursday as well. Exams start at 9am but **this week all students should arrive by 8.30am for the exam set up**. Students must return to their regular class after completing these exams.

Starting from June 17th students should arrive at 8.30am. When students do not have exams from June 17th onwards they are not expected in school. Diploma exams' dates cannot be changed so students who miss will have to take the exam in August at an alternative location. If

students are absent from school exams or PATs we can arrange an alternative sitting. Please let the school office know prior to 8.30am if a student will be absent for an exam.

The **exam timetable** is available on our website and displayed around the school for students.

All **assignments** are due to teachers on Friday June 14th. Students should make use of our teacher support sessions in the library at lunchtime to help them meet the deadline.

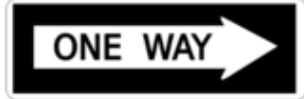

Important information about data migration for grade 12 students

GRADS - YOU MUST MOVE YOUR DATA AT THE END OF THE YEAR Or YOU WILL LOSE IT!.

- If you are **applying for post-secondary scholarships**, use a personal email account, not your CRPS email so you can still access them. You will need to move your data before you leave CCHS.
- Google has tools to help you including:
- **Download** – If there are only a few things you want to keep, including items shared with you, [download](#) a copy of individual files or folders.
- **Forward important emails** to another personal email account. [Learn more](#).
- **Transfer your content** – copy your Drive and Email files to a personal Google account. Learn [more](#).
- **Archive/Takeout** - download a copy of items owned by you in all G Suite services into one zip file. Learn [more](#).

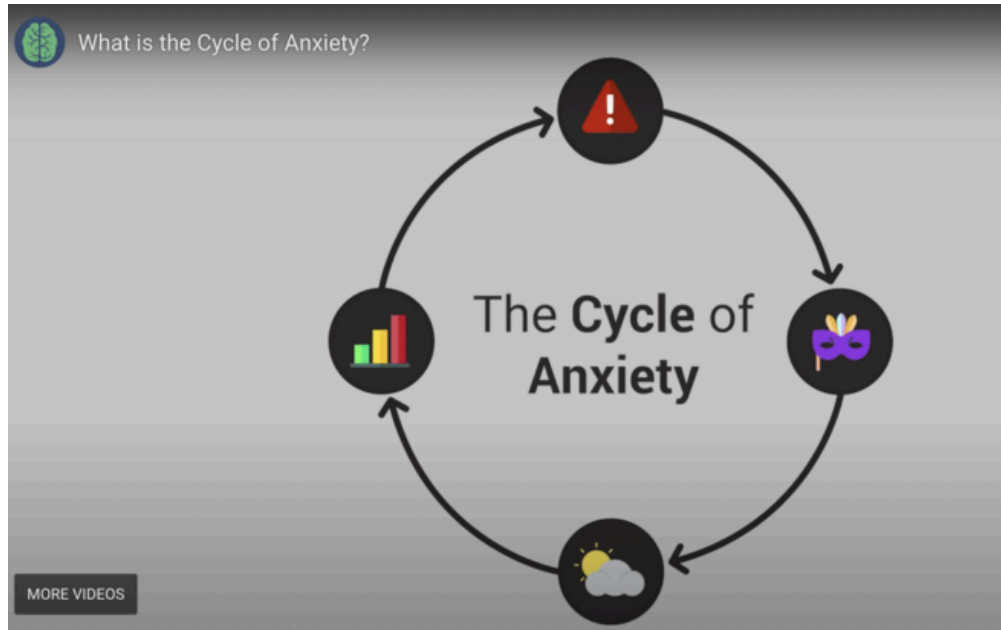
