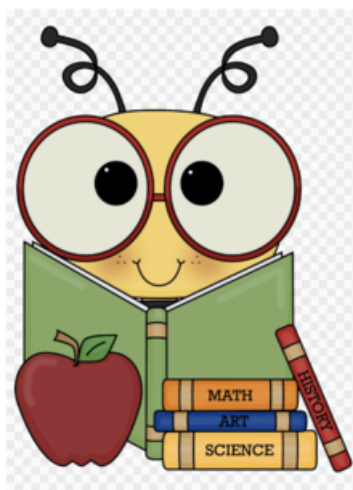
Exam Weeks June 17th - June 26th

Starting from June 17th students may arrive at 8:30 am when they have a schedule exam. When students do not have exams from June 17th onwards they are not expected in school. Students may prearrange with teachers a time to meet for additional support for exam prep but they shouldn't just drop in as teachers will be supervising exams at schedule times. **Diploma exams' dates cannot be changed** so students who miss the exam or arrive more than an hour late will have to take the exam in August at an alternative location. If students are absent from Grade 9 PATs we can only arrange an alternative sitting up until Thursday June 20th. For school exams we can arrange an alternative sitting up until Wednesday June 26th. Please let the school office know prior to 8.30am if a student will be absent for an exam. Students should come prepared to an exam with pens, pencils, calculators and anything else they have been advised to bring by their teachers.

What to expect on exam days!

1. Enjoy grab and go **breakfast** in the cafeteria each exam day
2. Leave **phones / backpacks / smart watches** locked in your LOCKER (or at home)
3. **Return your textbook** to the library the morning of your exam (unless your teacher provides another option)
4. Be at your exam location at 8:45am
5. **After your last exam**, hand in your **combination lock** at the main office.



Report Cards

Report cards will be available on **Friday, June 28 at 4:00 pm** in Parent Portal. Starting Friday, June 14, parents and students will not have access to grades while teachers prepare report cards. Marks and comments are not final until the official release of Report Cards on June 28.



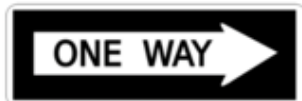

Important information about data migration for grade 12 students

GRADS - YOU MUST MOVE YOUR DATA AT THE END OF THE YEAR Or YOU WILL LOSE IT!.

- If you are **applying for post-secondary scholarships**, use a personal email account, not your CRPS email so you can still access them. You will need to move you data before you leave CCHS.
- Google has tools to help you including:
- **Download** – If there are only a few things you want to keep, including items shared with you, [download](#) a copy of individual files or folders.
- **Forward important emails** to another personal email account. [Learn more](#).
- **Transfer your content** – copy your Drive and Email files to a personal Google account. Learn [more](#).
- **Archive/Takeout** - download a copy of items owned by you in all G Suite services into one zip file. Learn [more](#).
- **Transfer Ownership** - If others will need to use files you own, you can transfer ownership to someone else at CRPS in sharing options, or they can take a copy for themselves. Learn [more](#).

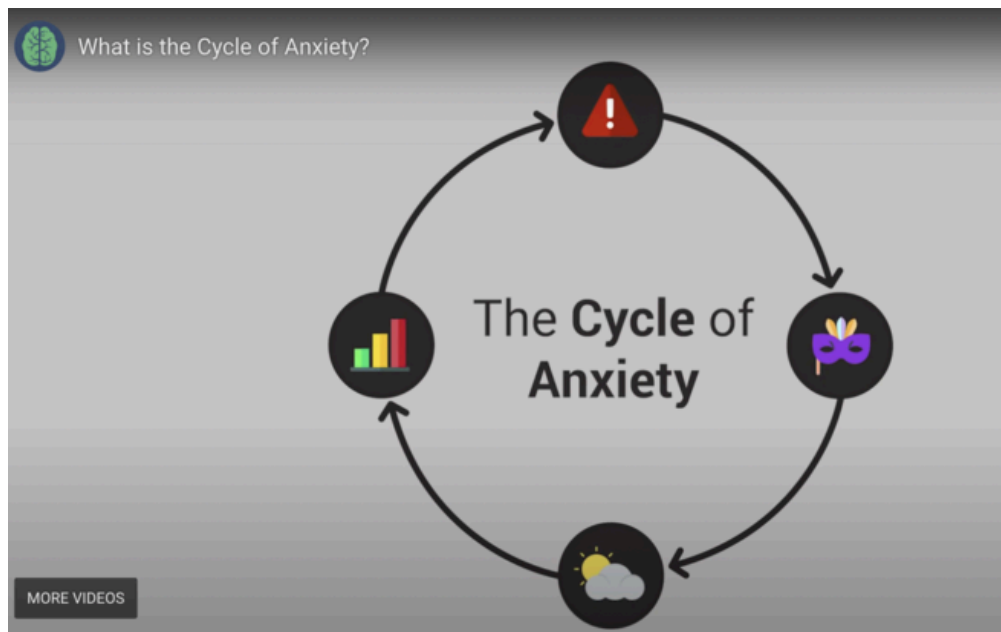
