WimWE Program Goals

- classroom community building
- teacher-student relationship building
- wellness: mental and physical health objectives
- nature and wilderness connection
- Avalanche Skills Training 1 certification (1 credit)
- additional opportunities for students to access outdoor pursuits and outdoor education outside of OE 9 and WILD



Each Grade 10 STEM class participates in:

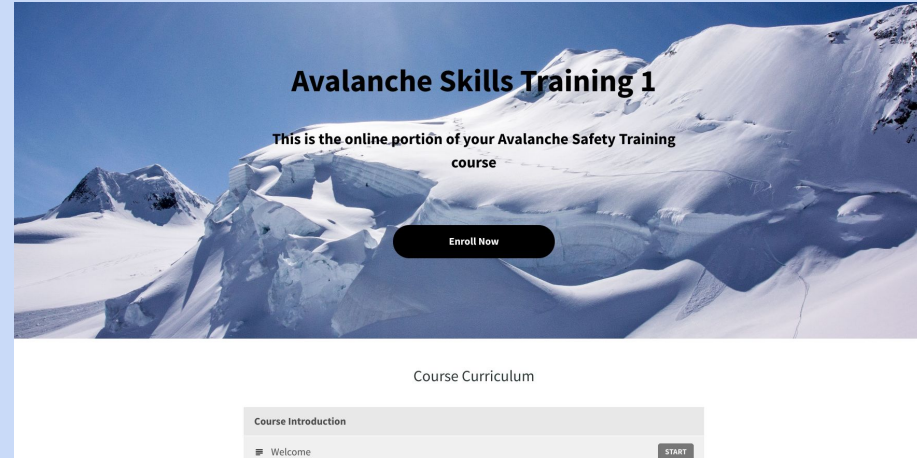
